Dear Minister;

I am writing this to express my grave concern on eight human rights defenders, including Amnesty International's Turkey Director İdil Eser, and two international IT trainers, who were detained by police on 5 July as they were participating in a workshop in Istanbul. I consider their detention is arbitrary and that their suspicion of "membership of an armed terrorist organisation" is baseless and ludicrous. Arbitrary detention is prohibited under international law.

So I should urge the Minister of Justice to release human rights defenders Günal Kurşun, İdil Eser, İlknur Üstün, Nalan Erkem, Nejat Taştan, Özlem Dalkıran, Şeyhmuz Özbekli, Veli Acu and the two IT international trainers Ali Gharavi and Peter Steudtner immediately and unconditionally.

Your quick attention on this matter would be highly appreciated.
