I am writing this letter to express my grave concern for an Iraqi woman, Basima Al-Jibouri who has served four years of a five-year sentence for espionage. She has been on hunger strike since 8 April and is critically ill.

I call on you to ensure that Basima Al-Jibouri has access to qualified health professionals acting in compliance with medical ethics, including the principles of confidentiality, autonomy, and informed consent.

I also call on you to ensure that she can have regular contact with her family, including visits.

I am very concerned that Revolutionary Court hearings in Iran are seriously flawed.
