## Your Excellency;

I am writing to express my deep concern that Dahmane Kerami remains imprisoned. He and other six people have been serving a one-year prison sentence for taking part in a peaceful protest in late December 2015 in Tamanrasset, southern Algeria and six men were released as part of a presidential pardon on 5 July.

Please take a prompt action to release Dahmane Kerami immediately and unconditionally, as he is a prisoner of conscience, jailed solely for the peaceful exercise of his right to freedom of expression and assembly .

I am calling on the authorities to amend legislation that criminalizes the rights to freedom of expression and peaceful assembly, including the Penal Code prohibiting "unarmed gatherings", "offending the President", and "offending public bodies".

I am also urging them to stop arresting, prosecuting and imprisoning those exercising their rights to freedom of expression and peaceful assembly.
