I am writing this to express my deep concern for a Myanmar-based educational professional, M. Furkan Sökmen and his family were detained in Yangon International Airport on 24 May while trying to board a flight to Bangkok. They were reportedly detained by Myanmar authorities for 24 hours at the airport after the Turkish government invalidated their passports. M. Furkan Sökmen was forced to board a flight to Istanbul, the Turkish capital, via Bangkok.

Could I be urging the Thai authorities to comply with their obligations under international human rights law not to deport, extradite or otherwise return M. Furkan Sökmen to a country where he would be at risk of torture, other ill-treatment or serious human rights violations? I should express my concern about the arbitrary manner in which M. Furkan Sökmen has reportedly been detained. The authorities should be asked to grant M. Furkan Sökmen immediate access to a lawyer and reminding them that in all proceedings the most rigorous internationally recognized standards for fair trial must be respected.

Your attention on this matter would be highly appreciated.
