Chechen human rights defender Oyub Titiev was arrested on false drug possession accusations on 9 January 2018 and has remained in detention ever since. On 11 January 2018, he was ordered to be held on remand for two months by the court.
I respectfully call on the Russian authorities to release Oyub Titiev immediately and unconditionally, and to drop all charges against him, as he is a prisoner of conscience detained solely in connection with his legitimate human rights work.
I strongly call on the authorities to ensure that human rights organisations in Russia, and in Chechnya specifically, including Human Rights Centre Memorial, can work without fear of persecution and intimidation.
